Description

The Summer Internship Program (the 'Program') is designed to provide exceptional students, who are interested in a career in sports, with a unique opportunity to learn about the diverse business operations of Major League Baseball. Those candidates selected for the Program will gain invaluable work experience through challenging project assignments, information sessions hosted by MLB senior management, and various other events organized by the recruitment team.

The Program begins on or about May 29th and requires a minimum commitment of 10 weeks. Opportunities may be available in a variety of departments including, but not limited to: Labor Relations, Special Events, Marketing, Corporate Sales, Legal Business Affairs, Community Affairs, Advertising, Information Technology, Human Resources, Finance, and Public Relations. Interns accepted into the program will receive a monthly stipend based on a five-day work week. All internship positions are based out of our New York City or Secaucus, NJ offices. Note that housing assistance will **not** be provided.

Eligibility:

All applicants must meet the following criteria for consideration in the Program:

- Have completed a minimum of two years in an accredited four-year college degree program or have completed at least one year of post-graduate education
- Excellent academic standing
- Strong verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills
- Proficiency with MS Office Suite including Excel and PowerPoint
- Some previous work experience (part-time, internship or volunteer) related to the department(s) of interest is strongly preferred

Application Process:

Prospective candidates must submit the following materials to receive full consideration for the Program. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

- Current resume
- Cover letter indicating the specific functional area(s) in which you are interested in
- Essay response to the following question:
 - What distinguishing aspect of a summer internship with MLB appeals most to you and how do you feel it will help you achieve your long-term career

aspirations?

All applications must be received no later than March 1, 2012. Please keep in mind that due to the anticipated volume of applications, we are unable to respond to individual phone inquiries or follow-up emails. If you are selected for an interview, you will be contacted in early March.
